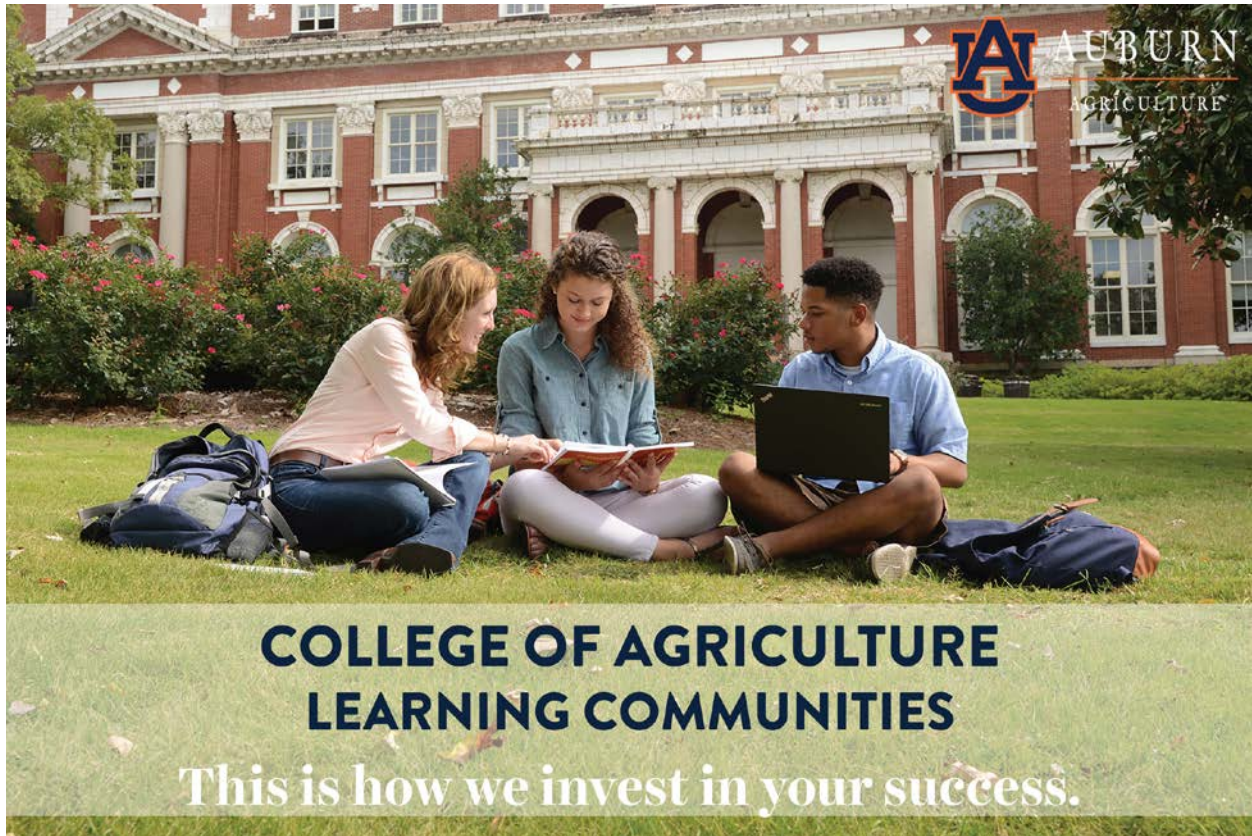


## Learning Community Postcards
